At the outset, Mr. Naveen Singh Panwar, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana has submitted on instructions from ASI Sudan Singh that in pursuance of the orders passed by this Court staying the arrest of the petitioner on 08.02.2021 the petitioner has joined investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation. He further submitted that the alleged recovery was of 2 Kg. 100 grams of ganja which does not fall in the category of commercial quantity.

In view of the aforesaid stand taken by the learned State counsel and the fact that the quantity involved was not a commercial quantity, the present petition is allowed.

It is directed that the petitioner shall continue to join investigation and cooperate with the investigation process and in the

event of his arrest, he shall be released on bail by the Arresting/Investigating Officer on his furnishing bail bonds/sureties to his satisfaction, subject to the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
