On the last date of hearing i.e. 11th February, 2022 following order was passed:

“ Learned counsel for the petitioners states that despite initiation of the proceedings of removal of encroachment upon the Gram Panchayat land especially the land earmarked for construction of Chopal for the backward class, the said proceedings since the year 2018 have not made any progress and there is no decision thereon till date.

Learned counsel for the State to seek instructions and inform the Court about the latest status of the said proceedings, as have been mentioned in the communication dated 03.12.2018 (Annexure P-4) received by the petitioners through CM Window.

List on 02.03.2022.

Learned counsel for the State to also seek instructions as to within how much time, the proceedings, so initiated, shall be concluded.”

In compliance with the said order, learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Jogesh Kumar, Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Chhachhrauli states that the next date of hearing before the Collector is 16th March, 2022, which is the date fixed for spot inspection by the Block Development and Panchayat Officer and to submit its report to the Collector. It is thereafter, that four months would be required for completing the proceedings, which is pending before the Collector initiated under Section 4 and 5 of Haryana Public Premises and Land (Evictions and Rent) Recovery Act, 1972, Annexure P-2. .

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the State on instructions, we disposed of the present petition binding down the respondents to the statement of the counsel for the State.

Ordered accordingly.
