1. The petitioners, who are residing in live-in relationship, have approached this Court seeking issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect their lives and liberty as they apprehend threat to the same at the hands of private respondents, who do not approve of their live-in relationship.
2. In compliance of order dated 24.01.2020, the State has filed its reply, which is accompanied by statements of the petitioners namely Amandeep Kaur and Palwinder Singh, both of whom have stated that as of now they do not have any apprehension as regards their security and that both of them are living happily in a rented accommodation. Joint affidavit of Harjit Singh, Pawanjit Kaur and Avtar Singh i.e. respondents No.4 to 6 has also been annexed as Annexure R-3/T, wherein they have deposed that Amandeep Kaur is their daughter/sister, who is residing with Palwinder Singh in a

rented accommodation and that they have no objection for the same.

3. In view of the aforestated position, the petition as of now is rendered infructuous, as the petitioners do not apprehend any kind of threat to their lives and liberty. As such, the same is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
4. It is, however, made clear that in case the petitioners apprehend any kind of threat to their lives and liberty at a later stage, it shall be open to them to approach this Court again seeking appropriate direction.
