The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents to take appropriate action in FIR No.729 dated 30.11.2021, registered under Sections 323, 324, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code (Sections 325, 326 of IPC added later on) at Police Station Narnaund, District Hisar.

It is contended that as per the injuries, Section 307 of Indian Penal Code is required to be added. In this regard, he relies upon medical report (Annexure P-2), discharge summary (Annexure P-3) and copy of MLR of the petitioner (Annexure P-4). Counsel for the petitioner submits that since as per the injuries suffered, Section 307 of IPC is required to be added, the petitioner has already moved representations to the State, but no

action has been taken. At this stage, counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to the extent that his representations dated 21.01.2022 (Annexure P-5) and dated 24.01.2022 (Annexure P-6) should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

At this stage, Mr. Kuldeep Tiwari, Addl. AG Haryana, who is appearing through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representations of the petitioner. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representations dated 21.01.2022 (Annexure P-5) and dated 24.01.2022 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
