Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to make the payment of ₹2,74,873/- (approximately) along with interest qua the works executed by the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that payment due to the petitioner has since been released. He thus submits that there is no surviving cause of action.
