otherwise, it is a case of recovery of contraband from the accused
amounting to commercial quantity, attracting the Bar of Section 37 of
the NDPS Act.

It seems that the petitioner is not interested in further
prosecution of the present petition. The same stands dismissed for
non-prosecution.
