SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. Both the petitions cast, under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., shall be disposed of through a common order, as they arise from a common petition FIR.

2. The learned State counsel submits that, in the petition FIR an incrimination was drawn against Parampreet Singh, Swaran Singh, Manjeet Singh, Rajan Chopra, Prince Chopra, Anil Chopra, Jatinder Kumar, and, Niti Soni. He further submits, on instructions given to him, by ASI Kulwinder Kumar that, during the course of investigations no inculpable evidence was discovered against co-accused Rajan Chopra, Prince Chopra,

Anil Chopra, Jatinder Kumar, and, Niti Soni, and, Swaran Singh, Manjeet Singh, and, that in respect of the above there would no inculpable mentions in the challan which becomes ultimately filed, before the learned Magistrate concerned.

3. If so, the learned counsel for the petitioner(s), in view of the above made statement, seek leave to withdraw the petition. Leave granted.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn.

5. However, the learned counsel for the complainant may at an appropriate stage hence choose to through an application cast, under Section 173(8) of Cr.P.C., before the learned trial Magistrate concerned, yet ask for further investigations being conducted, in respect of the incriminatory role, as assigned to the above persons, in the petition FIR.
