The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.926 dated 30.11.2021 under Sections 406, 420, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station City Karnal, District Karnal.

The operative part of the order dated 09.02.2022, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though there are allegations of giving money to the petitioner for procuring the loan and after the loan was sanctioned, some goods were purchased, but the same were never handed over to complainant Usha. It is further submitted that the petitioner has paid back an amount of Rs.49,000/- on 04.09.2021 through ATM and on 06.09.2021, by four transactions i.e. three transactions of Rs.25,000/- and one of Rs.20,000/-, thus, total Rs.1,44,000/- stands paid to the complainant.

List again on 04.05.2022.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 09.02.2022, has already appeared before the

SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhbir, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 09.02.2022, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
