Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0016 dated 11.01.2022 under Sections 186, 323, 353, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Line Par Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that pursuant to the order dated 01.02.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for investigation of the case.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Joginder Singh corroborates the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required for the purpose of investigation.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his

custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 01.02.2022 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
