Petitioners allege that both of them are major and they got married on 19.12.2021 against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6 who are related to petitioner No.1. Kamaljit Kaur is a divorcee and copy of ex parte decree of divorce is placed on file as Annexure P-6.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that aforesaid private respondents No.4 to 6 have threatened to cause harm to both the petitioners and in this regard, representation dated 15.1.2022 (Annexure P-5) was given to Senior Superintendent of Police Rural, Ludhiana but till date no action has been taken by the concerned authority in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.S.Khaira, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab. He submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police Rural, Ludhiana to consider representation dated 15.1.2022 (Annexure P-5) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners.
