1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 06.09.2021, in CWP-17121-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 06.09.2021 reveals that CWP-17121-2021., was dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty to the petitioner to file a statutory appeal and directions were issued to the competent authority to decide the same on receipt, in accordance with law, within three months.

3. At the outset, learned AAG, Punjab, has produced copy of order dated 01.03.2022, passed by the respondent deciding the appeal filed by the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that he does not press the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such with liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 01.03.2022, by way of

In view of order dated 01.03.2022, having been passed by the respondent in compliance of order Annexure P/1 dated 06.09.2021, in CWP-17121-2021 as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is called for against the respondent. Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 01.03.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.
