Prayer in the present second petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.469, dated 28.08.2021, registered under Sections 376, 120-B IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012, at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar.

By virtue of the order dated 06.07.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jarnail Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 06.07.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
