Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.754 dated 07.10.2020, under Sections 376, 511, 506 IPC and Section 3(1) (ii) of the Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station City, Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

By virtue of the order dated 08.03.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Jasbir Singh has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 08.03.2022, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
