On 28.02.2022, this Court passed the following order in the main
petition:-

“Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.212 dated 21.12.2020, registered for offences under Sections 304-B and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners, who are middle aged in-laws of the deceased, were found innocent during the course of inquiry as is apparent from the inquiry report (Annexure A-1) and they were found to be residing at some other place. He contends that the son of the deceased was suffering from a mental disorder as a result of which, the deceased used to remain under depression and unfortunately committed suicide. He urges that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is no longer required and they are ready for surrender before the Trial Court and will join the proceedings as they have been summoned as additional accused under Section 319, Cr.P.C.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

List on 14.07.2022.
Let the petitioners surrender before the Trial Court within a period of two weeks from today and join the proceedings. In case, they do so, the Trial Court shall release them on interim bail, subject to their furnishing bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction.”

Counsel for the petitioner has placed on record a *Xerox* copy of interim order dated 07.03.2022 passed by the Trial Court to submit that the petitioner has surrendered before the Trial Court and has been released on interim bail.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits, order dated 28.02.2022 is made absolute.

Petition is allowed.
