Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing result declared by the respondents vide letter dated 05.10.2018 (Annexure P-4) for appointment of Stenographer on transfer basis.

2. In the written statement filed on behalf of the respondents, following stand has been taken in Para-5 thereof:-

“5. That the dictation of English language which was suppose to be given for 5 minutes at a speed of 80 w.p.m. and the candidates were suppose to transcript at a speed of 15 w.p.m. leading to a total of 400 words was inadvertently given for 4 minutes thereby reducing the words from 400 to around 328 words and thereafter as per the instructions of the exam, the examiner calculated the result from 400 words. That the office of the answering respondent has duly considered the matter and has decided to quash the result dated 05.10.2018 (Annexure P-4) having been conducted against rules/ instructions in this regard and without any relaxation to conduct the same from 328 words. The orders quashing the result are appended therewith as Annexure R-1 (Colly). It is also submitted that the department has initiated the process of conducting the aforesaid exam afresh for which the applications have been invited by way of transfer

from other departments vide letter no.:A-46(B)/15654 dated 18.09.2019 (Annexure R-2).”

- In view of the aforesaid, nothing survives for adjudication before this Court. Writ petition is rendered infructuous and disposed of accordingly.
