1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 30.04.2019 in CWP No.11091 of 2019 in case titled as Mala Singh vs. State of Haryana and Ors.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that CWP No.11091 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the respondent to look into representation dated 01.02.2019 besides legal notice dated 20.02.2019 and pass appropriate order in respect thereto in accordance with law within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case. However, learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset states that needful has been done in terms of order, Annexure P/1 dated 30.04.2019, aforementioned representation and legal notice have been considered but the claim made therein has been rejected vide order dated 21.02.2022, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order dated 21.02.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
