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RAVI SHANKER JHA, C.J. (ORAL)

When confronted with a fact that an arbitration clause is required to be invoked for resolution of all the disputes, including termination of the contract and forfeiture of security, learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that as the impugned order has been passed by the Appellate Authority itself, the respondent-authorities have conceded and agreed to the request of the petitioner to refer the matter to the sole arbitrator Dr. Justice Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, a former Judge of this Court.

Learned Additional Advocate General, appearing for the respondent-State of Haryana, submits that though there is a provision of filing an appeal, but on instructions from Mr. Anurag Rastogi, IAS, Additional Chief Secretary (PWD), Haryana, he submits that the parties have agreed to refer the matter to the sole independent Arbitrator, Dr. Justice Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, a former Judge of this Court.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the agreement arrived at between the parties and the consent given by the respondent-State of Haryana for appointment of sole independent arbitrator, he wishes to withdraw the petition with liberty to initiate arbitration proceedings before the sole arbitrator Dr. Justice Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, a former Judge of this Court.

In view of the statements made by learned counsel for both the parties, the petition stands disposed of.
