Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in DDR No.11 dated 22.08.2020 under Section 29 of NDPS Act, in FIR No.183 dated 17.08.2020 under Sections 15(B), 18(C), 25 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 15.02.2021, arrest of the petitioner was stayed and thereafter, vide order dated 06.10.2021, he was directed to join the investigation subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gulshan Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the orders dated 15.02.2021 & 06.10.2021, vide which the petitioner was granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail, are made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
