[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 08.02.2019, in CWP No.3466 of 2019 in case titled as '**Vidhi Chand and others** versus **State of Punjab and others.**'

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No. 3466 of 2019, was disposed of vide order dated 08.02.2019 with directions to take appropriate decision on the claim of the petitioners within three weeks.

[3] Learned Asstt. AG, Punjab, has filed short affidavit of Shri R.K. Mishra, IFS, Principal Chief Conservator of Forest i.e. respondent No.2. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal thereof states that the petitioners' claim has been partly accepted and payment in respect thereto released, therefore, he does not press the instant petition but prays for

liberty to challenge order (Annexure R-1) dated 19.06.2020 and 20.12.2020 to the extent the same is adverse to the interest of the petitioner to claim benefits as per entitlement.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
