This is a second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR no.0160 dated 20.06.2020 registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances, Act, 1985 (in short "NDPS Act") (Sections 29/61/85 of the NDPS Act added later on) at Police Station Dinanagar, Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks to withdraw the present petition, at this stage. Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that the trial in the present case be expedited as the FIR is of the year 2020 and out of 11 prosecution witnesses, one witness has been examined and all the witnesses are police officials.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage.

The trial Court is requested to proceed with the trial as expeditiously as possible. The State is also directed to examine the witnesses as expeditiously as possible.

Pending miscellaneous application, if any, stands disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
