The State of Punjab assails the correctness of the order passed by the Executing Court, on 13.12.2013, in an execution petition.

It has been pointed out that the decree holder was working for the Punjab State and pursuant to an order passed by the Supreme Court of India, dated 07.11.2001, she was given various benefits. It has been pointed out that the decree holder has already died on 25.11.2019. It is also not in dispute that certain benefits which are claimed to be not payable have already been paid, subject to the result of the execution petition. The decree holder has died and the payment has already been paid, therefore, no further order is required to be passed.

The learned counsel representing the decree holder has stated that all the dues have already been paid and the execution petition has been

withdrawn.

Disposed of accordingly.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
