Present petition has been filed with a prayer that the respondents be directed not to call the petitioner and her husband Pal Singh to the Police Station without there being any FIR registered against them and without following the due procedure under the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gaurav Bansal, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Learned counsel for the respondents-State submits that he has

instructions to submit that the petitioner will not be unnecessarily called to the police station and in case, petitioner's presence in any case, the petitioner will be summoned in accordance with the provisions of Cr.P.C.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in fact, respondent No.5 has already feasted at the expense of the petitioner of Rs.2,000/- on 24.01.2022 and in regards to same, the petitioner has filed a representation dated 29.01.2022 (Annexure P-2) with the Superintendent of Police, Karnal, which is still pending consideration with the said authority and the same may kindly be decided expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the respondents-State submits that representation dated 29.01.2022 (Annexure P-2) will be decided by respondent No.3 within a period of eight weeks from today by passing appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
