When confronted with the issue of maintainability of the petition as a private interest litigation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to pursue his representation dated 06.01.2022 (Annexure P-10) relating to cutting of trees illegally and using the land for commercial purposes, pending before respondent No.4 which may be directed to be considered and decided by the authorities concerned.

Learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondent-State of Haryana submits that the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner shall be considered by the authorities concerned and a decision thereon would be taken expeditiously in accordance with law preferably within a period of two weeks and communicated to the petitioner.
