The petitioner was granted the interim bail by the trial Court, vide order dated 26.07.2021 awaiting the report of Chemical Examiner.

Learned State counsel submits that now the report of the Chemical Examiner has been received and the petitioner, without surrendering before the trial Court, has filed the present petition seeking anticipatory bail.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer and submits that petitioner may be granted liberty to surrender before the trial Court and the trial Court may be directed that if the petitioner moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same be decided expeditiously.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court that in case the petitioner surrenders before it

within a period of seven days from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be decided within a period of three days thereafter.
