The learned Appellate Court may also consider to pass orders separately, upon the application seeking composition of the offence, arising out of dishonour of the negotiable instrument, and, upon the appeal, which is preferred by the aggrieved, against the verdict recorded by the learned Judicial Magistrate concerned, hence convicting, and, sentencing the petitioner, for his committing the offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.
