In a suit filed under Section 92 of the Code of Civil Procedure,
1908, the trial Court has permitted the plaintiffs to amend the plaint.

The defendant has filed the present revision petition.

This Bench has heard the learned counsel representing the
parties at length and with their able assistance perused the paper book.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that
since the names of certain defendants have been deleted by way of an
application filed by the petitioner herein, therefore, the amendment could not
have been allowed.

Per contra, the learned counsel representing the plaintiff
submits that new trustees have already been impleaded as defendants by way
of an amendment.

In the considered opinion of the Court, such matter can be
decided after the parties are permitted to lead evidence. At this stage, no
ground to interfere with the order passed by the trial Court is made out.

Dismissed.

Needless to observe that the parties shall be entitled to take all the objections before the trial Court.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
