Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to consider and appoint the petitioner against the posts lying vacant in the department.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that instead of pressing the writ petition on merits, his client would be satisfied at this stage, in case, representation dated 05.01.2022 (P-10) is decided expeditiously.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.3-Director, Education Recruitment Directorate,

Punjab, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 05.01.2022 (P-10), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
