This is claimants' appeal seeking modification of
award passed by MACT, Sangrur.

On request, the instant matter is taken up in Bi-
Lok Adalat, accordingly discussed.

As per statements of learned counsel for the
appellants and learned counsel for the Insurance Company
(separately recorded), a sum of Rs.4,50,000/- (Rupees Four
Lac Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount already
awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full &
final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the
statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced
amount be paid to appellant No.1-Gurmeet Kaur Wd/o Shri
Sukhvir Singh @ Sukha.

Accordingly, we dispose off this case with a
direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-
cheque for Rs.4,50,000/- in the name of appellant No.1 with
the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within six
weeks from today, in compliance of this order, failing which,
interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till

payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent - Insurance Company. The appellants' counsel/appellants may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of this order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
