In a proceeding under Section 30 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, the petitioners were proceeded against ex-parte on 04.10.2012. Their application for setting aside an ex-parte proceeding was dismissed by the Court on 19.08.2014. This revision petition is pending in this court for the last 8 years.

After addressing arguments at some length, the learned counsels representing the parties have reached at a consensus. It has been agreed that the petitioners will be permitted to produce revenue record as specified in the affidavit of Sunil Kumar son of Sh. Bhuria.

The learned counsel representing the respondents submits that though the aforesaid revenue record is already exhibited but he has no objection, if the petitioners are once again permitted to produce those documents.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the certified copy of the revenue record enlisted in the affidavit shall be permitted to be produced and considered because these documents are per-se admissible. Thereafter, the

Court will proceed to decide the matter positively within a period of 6 months, from today.

Disposed of accordingly.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
