Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case, the petitioner is being harassed by the respondents No. 4 and 5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vehicle No. PB-11-BK/7745 has been sold by the petitioner to respondent No. 5 and now, respondent No. 5 is making complaint against the petitioner and respondent No. 4, who is working in Police, as acting on behalf of the private respondents and pressurizing the petitioner to refund the amount, which the petitioner received after selling his vehicle to respondent No. 5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No. 4 has threatened the petitioner with dire consequences including implicating him in some false case, which grievance has already been raised by the petitioner before respondent No. 2-

28.01.2022 (Annexure P-4), which is still pending consideration. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the representation dated 28.01.2022 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned State counsel raises no objection in decision of the representation dated 28.01.2022 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the representation dated 28.01.2022 (Annexure P-4) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present petition stands disposed of.
