[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for taking action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 13.11.2019 in CWP No.32614 of 2019.

[3] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.32614 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the competent authority to decide the representation moved by the petitioner by passing a speaking order within 04 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[4] Learned counsel contends that the instant petition was filed on account of failure of the respondent to do the needful.

[5] Learned DAG states that the respondent has passed order dated 17.12.2019, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in the representation moved by the petitioner.

dated 17.12.2019 having been passed in compliance of order dated 13.11.2019, he does not press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 17.12.2019 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[7] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, no action is called for against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. Accordingly, the contempt petition is *disposed of* as such, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 17.12.2019 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.
