HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at the time of death of father of the petitioner, two options were available with the family. First was to get the compassionate appointment and the second was for getting compassionate financial assistance. Learned counsel submits that the family had decided with regard to the grant of a compassionate appointment to the petitioner, who was minor at that time but now, as the said prayer is not being accepted, the petitioner is entitled for the compassionate financial assistance, which benefit was available to the family at the time of the death of petitioner's father. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case the respondents consider the grant of said benefit in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case, the petitioner files an appropriate representation seeking the claim of compassionate financial assistance, which was admissible to the petitioner at the time of his

father's death, the same will be considered and decided in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 4 weeks from the receipt of any such representation. Learned State counsel further submits that in case, after the decision of the said representation, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will also be released to him within a period of 4 weeks thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the aforesaid statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate representation seeking the grant of compassionate financial assistance.

Ordered accordingly.
