Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No. 0017 dated 05.12.2018 registered under Sections 171, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC at P.S. Asodha, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the previous orders passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and also gave answers to the questionnaire which was given to him by the investigating officer.

Status report by way of affidavit of Amit Yashvardhan, IPS, Additioanal Superintendent of Police Badli, on behalf of respondent-State has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar has not disputed the aforesaid assertions made by the learned counsel

for the petitioner and further submits that the questionnaire put to the petitioner has been answered by him and the petitioner has also joined the investigation with the police and now the petitioner is not required by the police for any investigation or custodial interrogation.

In the light of the above without commenting on the merits of the case the present petition is hereby allowed and order of interim bail dated 04.02.2022 is hereby made absolute. However the petitioners are directed to abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
