Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.108 dated 10.12.2021, under Sections 326, 323, 336, 354, 452, 379, 148,149 IPC, 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Khalra, District Tarn Taran.

By virtue of the order dated 18.05.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sarabjit Singh has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more

required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 18.05.2022, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
