GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.81 dated 26.05.2018 registered at Police Station City, District Hoshiarpur, under Sections 323/379-B/34 IPC (Section 379-B IPC stands deleted) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 24.01.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioners, namely, Hardeep Kumar, Shubham Thakur

and Amritpal Singh Kang as well as of complainant Jorawar Singh and injured Ikjot Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant Jorawar Singh and injured Ikjot Singh in their statements have stated that they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.81 dated 26.05.2018 registered at Police Station City, District Hoshiarpur, under Sections 323/379-B/34 IPC (Section 379-B IPC stands deleted) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
