The present petition has been filed under Section 438 CrPC for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner in FIR No.205dated21.11.2019 registered under Sections353,186, 332, 324, 506, 34 IPC (Section201 IPC added subsequently) at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not wish to press the present petition. However, he seeks the indulgence of this Court that in case the petitioner surrenders within a period of next 07 days and moves an application for bail, the same be decided expeditiously.

In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed.

However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate within 07 days from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be heard and decided expeditiously.
