GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect his life and liberty.

Without commenting anything as regards the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur to get examined the alleged threat perception of the petitioner. In case, it is found that there is genuine threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner, then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.

It shall be open to the petitioner to move a detailed representation as regards his threat perception to respondent No.4 within a week from today.

It is further directed that in case any information is to be elicited from the petitioner, then a prior written notice be afforded to him before summoning him.

It is, however, clarified that the aforesaid order shall not confer any immunity upon the petitioner, in case it is found that he has committed any wrong.
