Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking anticipatory bail in case of FIR No.43 dated 18.6.2020, under Sections 307, 326, 323, 324, 341, 148, 149, 379 IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Bholath District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing at some length and realizing that the present petition is against the rejection of third anticipatory bail by the trial Court and the fact that earlier two petitions were dismissed does not find mention in the pleadings, restricts his prayer and submits that the petitioner shall surrender within one week and apply for regular bail, his bail petition be decided expeditiously.

As the prayer for anticipatory bail is not being pressed, the petition is disposed of.

In case, the petitioners surrenders within one week from today and applies for regular bail, the court concerned shall take up the bail application within two days and decide it as expeditiously as possible.
