ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Prayer in the present petition is for cancellation of bail granted to respondents No.2 & 3 vide order dated 04.08.2020 (Annexure P-4)

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the only order which would suffice purpose of this petition is that two further conditions will be added in the order dated 04.08.2020 passed in CRM-M-21453-2020, vide which, bail was granted to the petitioners (respondents No.2 & 3 herein). Further conditions are as follows:-

1. "Given the nature of allegations and the other circumstances peculiar to this case, the petitioner (respondents No.2 & 3 herein) shall surrender all weapons, firearms, ammunition, if any, along with the arms license to the concerned authority within ten days from today and inform the Investigator about the compliance. However, subject to the Indian Arms Act, 1959, the petitioner shall be entitled to renew and take it back in case of acquittal in this case.

2. Respondents No.2 & 3 shall neither stare, stalk, make any gestures, remarks, call, contact, message the victim, either physically, or through phone call or any other social media, nor roam around the victim's home. They shall stay at a distance of 100 meter (radius) of the Village till the recording of the statement of the complainant.

Petition is allowed to the extent above.
