Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.19 dated 11.01.2022 under Section 21(b)/61 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Adampur, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the police arrested co-accused Krishan, who is brother-in-law of the petitioner and recovered 30 grams of heroin and on the basis of his disclosure statement, the petitioner was nominated in the present FIR.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner is involved

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in as many as 05 more FIRs, out of which one is under NDPS Act and four FIRs under IPC, detail of which is given as below: -

1. FIR No.185 dated 02.08.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 341 IPC, Police Station Bhattu Kalan, District Fatehabad.
2. FIR No.127 dated 21.05.2018 under Sections 323, 325, 506, 34 IPC, Police Station Adampur.
3. FIR No.103 dated 25.04.2018 under Sections 323, 341, 34 IPC, Police Station Adampur.
4. FIR No.14 dated 29.03.2019 under Sections 332, 353 IPC and Section 146 of Railway Act, Police Station GRP, Sirsa.
5. FIR No.149 dated 14.08.2019 under Section 21 of NDPS Act, Police Station Adampur.

Though nomination of the petitioner in the FIR is on basis of disclosure statement of co-accused Krishan, who is not a stranger, but his real brother-in-law, coupled with the fact that the petitioner is involved in other cases including one case under NDPS Act, therefore, looking into his antecedents, I find no ground to grant him the concession of anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
