The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.141 dated 22.12.2021 registered under Sections 363, 366-A IPC at Police Station, City-II, Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

By virtue of the order dated 21.4.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to order dated 21.4.2022 petitioner has duly joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has submitted that in pursuance to order dated 21.4.2022 petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation. He also submits that as per the information provided to him prosecutrix is married with the petitioner.

In view of the above, the order dated 21.4.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
