Prayer in this petition is for transfer of a petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act from District Court, Fatehgarh Sahib to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Rupnagar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has filed a petition under the Domestic Violence Act, which is pending before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Rupnagar and she has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. claiming maintenance for herself as well as her minor son. However, in the meantime, the respondent, in a counter-blast has filed a petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, for dissolution of the marriage at Fatehgarh Sahib. It is further submitted that the petitioner has no independent source of income and it is difficult for her to travel and defend the case properly at Fatehgarh Sahib.

There is no representation on behalf of the respondent.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, pending in

District Court, Fatehgarh Sahib, is ordered to be transferred to the court
of competent jurisdiction at Rupnagar.
