SANT PARKASH, J.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.07 dated 12.01.2022, registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act (No.61 of 1985) at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur.

It is contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case as nothing has been recovered from her possession. The alleged recovery i.e.300 intoxicating tablets of Tramwell SR 100, which falls under non-commercial quantity, has been planted against the petitioner by the police. It is further contended that although there is one other criminal case against the present petitioner, but she has been granted bail in the same.

Heard.

After having gone through the case file, it is clear that the petitioner was identified at the spot and she ran away on seeing the police party and threw the carry bag containing the intoxicant tablets carried by

her in her right hand and on checking the same, 300 intoxicant tablets of Tramwell SR 100 were recovered. Moreover, there is one more case pending against the present petitioner for same offence under NDPS Act., which shows that she is a habitual offender and there is every possibility that she would indulge in similar activities if she is granted the concession of bail.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court do not find any ground to grant the petitioner concession of anticipatory bail and therefore, her request for the same is declined.

Petition stands dismissed.
