SANT PARKASH, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.52 dated 21.10.2020, registered under Section 67-A Information Technology (Amendment) Act, 2008 and Section 506 IPC at Police Station Women Narnaul, District Mahendergarh.

On 24.11.2021, this Court passed the following orders:-

“This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of prearrest bail to petitioner in case FIR No.52 dated 21.10.2020 under Section 67-A of Information Technology (Amendment) Act, 2008, and Section 506 IPC, registered at Women Police Station Narnaul, District Mahendergarh.

Learned counsel for petitioner inter alia contends that version, as alleged in the FIR, is totally concocted one and there is no iota of truth therein. He further submits that in case FIR No.129 dated 14.10.2019 under Sections 328, 354-C, 354-D, 366-A, 376(2)(n), 406, 506 and 509 IPC (Section 4 of POCSO Act added later on), registered at Women Police Station Narnaul, District Mahendergarh, petitioner has already been admitted to bail by this Court, vide order dated 28.08.2020 (Annexure P-2). He further submits that petitioner is willing to join investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency.

Adjourned to 12.01.2022.

Meanwhile, in the eventuality of arrest of petitioner in the instant case FIR, he shall be enlarged on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer/ Investigating Officer. Petitioner shall join investigation on 29.11.2021 at 10 AM sharp before the Investigating Officer at Women Police Station Narnaul, District Mahendergarh and on any other subsequent date as informed to him by the Investigating Officer. Petitioner shall abide by conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.”

Upon instructions from SI Raj Kala, learned State counsel submits that in compliance of the aforesaid orders, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 24.11.2021 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
