The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to release an amount of ₹1,98,840/- for medical reimbursement with interest @ 18% on delayed payment from the date due till payment; along with certain other prayers.

On the last date of hearing following order was passed:

“No document has been placed on record pursuant to the order passed by this Court on 26.02.2021. Thereafter, the case has been taken up twice, however, either the counsel for the petitioner has not come present or he had sought time. Today again, there is no representation on behalf of the

petitioner. Although, the case would have been dismissed for non-prosecution, however, in the interest of justice, the petitioner is granted one more opportunity to do the needful.

Adjourned to 14.03.2022.”

Today again the counsel for the petitioner has not joined the proceedings. Therefore, it is clear that the petitioner is not interested in prosecuting the present petition.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
