petition i.e. CWP-2511 of 2021, which is pending for 27.09.2022.

Notice of the application to the counsel for the opposite side.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General,
Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of non-
applicant/respondents-State.

Learned counsel for the parties are agreed that the hearing of
the main writ petition, which is adjourned for 27.09.2022 be preponed.

Keeping in view the joint request of learned counsel for the
parties, the aforesaid application is allowed. The hearing of main petition
i.e. CWP-2511 of 2021 is preponed for today and the main case is taken
up for hearing.

CWP-2511 of 2021

In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioner is for the release of the pensionary benefits for which he is entitled for after the retirement.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, at the time of retirement, there were certain disciplinary proceedings pending against the petitioner and in those proceedings, though the enquiry report has already been submitted by the Enquiry Officer but the same has been kept pending without any valid justification, which act on the part of the respondents is causing prejudice to the petitioner as the petitioner is not being extended the retiral benefits.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, learned Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the assertion of the petitioner that the enquiry report has already been submitted by the Enquiry Officer is correct, the appropriate order on the disciplinary proceedings will be passed within a period of two months of the receipt of copy of this order and thereafter, the claim of the petitioner will be considered for the release of the pensionary benefits and within a period of four weeks thereafter, whatever the petitioner is found entitled for, will be released to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, no further grievance of the

petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.
