[1] Prayer in thepetition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 04.04.2019, in CWP No.9140 of 2019 in case titled as '**Ramesh Chander Munjal** versus**State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.9140 of 2019, was disposed of by directing the respondent to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of legal notice dated 06.02.2019 expeditiously and in any case within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and further that if any amount was found due, the same be released to the petitioner without any further delay.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that needful having been done in terms of order (Annexure P-1) dated 04.04.2019 in CWP No.9140 of 2019, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
