Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking anticipatory bail in case of FIR No. 1 dated 5.1.2022, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 419 IPC, 1860, and 120-B IPC 1860 (added lateron), registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Vide order dated 3.2.2022, the petitioner was directed to join investigation subject to complying the condition as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagjit Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is co-operating. It is further informed that the petitioner has deposited cash security of Rs.50,000/-.

The amount deposited shall be kept in FDRs in a nationalized bank subject to out come of trial.

As no custodial interrogation is needed, the interim bail granted on 3.2.2022 is made absolute.
