[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 22.01.2021 in CWP No.21323 of 2020 in case titled as Ziaul Haque vs. State of Haryana and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that the claim of the petitioner in the writ petition was with regard to non-release of salary despite his having tested positive for COVID-19. Writ petition was disposed of with the direction to the competent authority to look into the matter by taking into account the certificate of the petitioner having tested positive for COVID-19 and to take necessary action in respect thereto but in case of an order adverse to the petitioner, a speaking order was to be passed and conveyed to the petitioner.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that payment of salary to the petitioner even for the period he could not attend

him, therefore, in the circumstances, he does not wish to press the instant petition.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
