Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in the present petition petitioners are claiming the benefit of regularization with effect from the date person junior to them have been regularized.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the employees junior to the petitioners working in the same district have been regularized and therefore, they are also entitled for the grant of the said benefit.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised through the legal notice dated 20.10.2018. Copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-5 and the

petitioners will be satisfied at this stage in case the time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate order.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits no objection for deciding the legal notice (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner and further submitted that in case any of the junior of the petitioners in the same district has been regularized, the detail of which is substantiated by the petitioners, appropriate consideration will be given to the claim of the petitioners as well and an appropriate order on the legal notice (Annexure P-5) will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel for deciding the legal notice (Annexure P-5) in the time bound manner, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.
